Overview

For several years, Chris Deaver has presented time-honored principles related to responsibility to executives, aspiring professionals from every field, youth groups, and elementary school students. His passion for the historic Statue of Responsibility monument project is represented in his goal to bring its message to everyone.

In an entertaining, enlightening, and empowering presentation, Chris explores with listeners the importance of responsibility as a crucial and exciting component to freedom.

History

As a Member of the Statue of Responsibility Foundation, an organization of volunteers from 19 U.S. states and 17 foreign countries dedicated to building the Statue of Responsibility on the west coast of America, Chris introduces the monument project to audiences throughout the world.

Chris has provided consulting and services to several Fortune 500 companies and currently drives engagement initiatives at Dell, Inc. He has launched global programs for the entire employee population. Most recently, Chris has been deeply involved in recruiting as well as leading efforts to empower employees to get mentored as well as create social relevance and drive sales of Dell products and services.

Through the 501(c)3 non-profit organization that he co-founded, the International Mentoring Network Organization (IMNO), Chris has enabled people throughout the world to achieve their potential through mentoring. He performed countless interviews with successful professionals and co-designed a global mentoring program, influencing aspiring professionals in over 70 countries. His work with IMNO has been featured in Fast Company Magazine, Forbes, and Entrepreneur and been presented to schools including Duke University. Chris' new mentoring book, *Get in Their Shoes*, will soon be available to audiences everywhere.

Having earned an MBA at the Marriott School at Brigham Young University (BYU), Chris focused his studies on marketing, training, and organizational development. He served as Vice President of Special Operations for Net Impact, engaging in corporate social responsibility initiatives. Chris also possesses a Bachelors degree in Visual Arts, with an emphasis in Animation from BYU. Skilled in the creative arts, Chris continues to produce storyboards, animations, cartoons, and fine art for various organizations and national publications on a freelance basis.

Chris has served in the Boy Scouts of America for over a decade, and is an Eagle Scout. He is also a triathlete and enjoys studying the martial arts. He loves spending time with his wife Julia and building (and destroying) Lego towers with his son, Danny.

He has recently begun working on the Statue of Responsibility monument project.

International Appeal

Freedom is an ideal that rings true for all nationalities. The International Monument Pathway, which will surround the Statue of Responsibility, reflects this reality. Mr. Deaver includes details of this important aspect of the project in his presentation.

More About the Foundation

The Statue of Responsibility Foundation is committed to seeing the inspirational idea of Dr. Viktor E. Frankl become a reality. In the 1960's, and as printed in his landmark book, *Man's Search for Meaning*, Frankl said, "*Freedom is not the last word. Freedom is only part of the story and half of the truth. The positive aspect of freedom is responsibility. That is why I recommend that the Statue of Liberty on the East Coast be supplemented by a Statue of Responsibility on the West Coast.*"

The Statue of Responsibility Foundation, a 501(c)(3), non-profit corporation, has a two-fold mission: First, to raise the funding necessary to construct the monument. Second, and more long-term in nature, is to establish an educational scholarship fund. Scholarships will be given to applicants who have financial need and who can demonstrate how they have applied the principle of responsibility in their life – and how they plan to implement this principle following their university graduation.

The Foundation is comprised of volunteers from 19 U.S. states and 16 foreign countries.
