Overview

As an educator, entrepreneur, inventor, and leader of what has been called the most compelling monument project to freedom in the 21st Century, Daniel Louis Bolz has been presenting this historic undertaking to audiences for many years. His message about the Statue of Responsibility monument project is inspiring, educational and motivating.

In a lively, interactive and fact-filled presentation, Daniel guides his listeners along a historical depiction of “freedom’s path”, and in the process explains what it takes to preserve freedom today.

History

As President & CEO of the Statue of Responsibility Foundation, an organization of volunteers from 19 U.S. states and 17 foreign countries dedicated to building the Statue of Responsibility on the west coast of America, Daniel has spoken to thousands of adults and school students

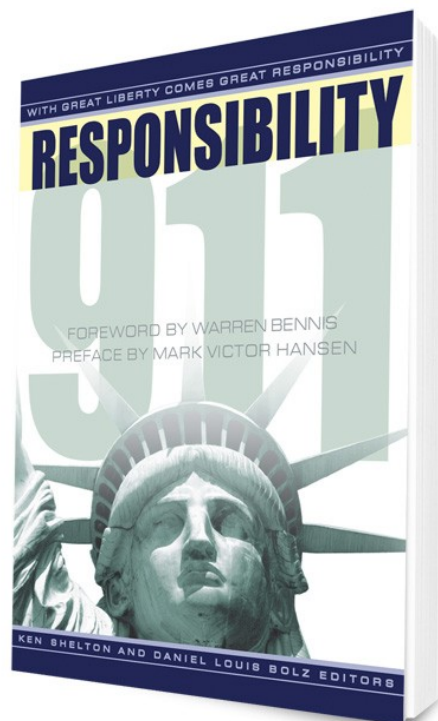
since 2002. He has introduced the monument project to audiences in Vienna, Austria and Buenos Aires, Argentina, plus several locations in the United States.

Daniel's background encompasses the worlds of art, education, and business. His passion for the arts was developed at a young age through his mother's work as a playwright, actress, and director of a children's television program. Daniel's professional training came from universities in Michigan and Utah where he studied art, political science, community education administration, and business management. He holds a BA in Political Science and Art, a M.Ed. in Educational Administration, and an MBA. He has lived and worked in New York, Michigan, Utah, Germany, and Scotland. He has been working on the Statue of Responsibility monument project since 2002.

"As a third generation Army veteran, working to see this monument built is my way of preserving freedom, just as my great-grandfather did in WWI in France, and my father did in WWII in Germany. My call to defend freedom with a weapon came in 1972 during the Vietnam War. I spent three years in Germany with the NATO forces when the 'cold war' was still a reality. Now I choose, or I believe that the project has chosen me, to continue the cause of preserving freedom in a peaceful fashion. I intend to do all that I can to see that this monument gets built," said Bolz.

Bolz and the monument project have been featured in local, state, national and international media including live on-line interviews.

Bolz is co-editor of the Foundation's first publication, **Responsibility 911**.



The 56 authors in this anthology make a strong and diversified case for the role responsibility plays in a free society. **Responsibility 911** is a great year long executive/employee training tool (one article per week) of insight into what keeps democracy alive, and what each of our individual opportunities are to preserve it.

More About the Foundation

The Statue of Responsibility Foundation is committed to seeing the inspirational idea of Dr. Viktor E. Frankl become a reality. In the 1960's, and as printed in his landmark book, *Man's Search for Meaning*, Frankl said, "*Freedom is not the last word. Freedom is only part of the story and half of the truth. The positive aspect of freedom is responsibility. That is why I recommend that the Statue of Liberty on the East Coast be supplemented by a Statue of Responsibility on the West Coast.*"

The Statue of Responsibility Foundation, a 501(c)(3), non-profit corporation, has a two-fold mission: First, to raise the funding necessary to construct the monument. Second, and more long-term in nature, is to establish an educational scholarship fund. Scholarships will be given to applicants who have financial need and who can demonstrate how they have applied the principle of responsibility in their life – and how they plan to implement this principle following their university graduation.

The Foundation is comprised of volunteers from 19 U.S. states and 16 foreign countries.
